Clinic Participant Details

Clinic Schedule:

- **9:00 AM : Meet without horses for Meet and Greet and Setups for success.**
- **10:00 AM : Short Break**
- **12:30 PM : Lunch break**
- **1:30 PM : Afternoon session begins**
- **4:00 PM : Private 20 minute sessions begin.**
- *Playground is weather and muddy permitting; Small indoor arena is available, alternate plans available if Mother Nature has her own plan.*

- A beautiful farm back a long lane. Look for the signs at the end of drive. Their drive is next to the two cell phone towers.

Load In/Parking:

- You may arrive any time on the day before your clinic starts.
- If you arrive the day before the clinic I will be there to greet you. If you are planning on coming the day of your clinic please arrive by 8:00 a.m.
- Please park your trailer & truck in the designated pasture; you may use your trailer for a trailer loading session. (Trailer parking is available for all Right Brained Humans in need! Please go slow and right!)
- Always be mindful that as you arrive with your horse, people may be riding their horses, so please be courteous when checking in.

Check In:

- Please check in with the coordinator when you arrive.
- At check-in you will need to:
 - Provide a copy of a current coggins & health certificate if you are travelling from out of state
 - Provide a signed copy of the Jesse Peters release agreements if you have not already sent it or have it on file
 - Schedule your 20 minute private session time slot with Jesse

Clinic Start/Stop Times:

- You don't want to miss a thing so be ready before 9:00am. You will just need to bring yourself without your horse for the first part of the morning. Then we will head out with horses and instructions. We will focus on a variety of tasks with lots of simulations and interactions. Questions, comments and clarifications are appreciated and encouraged.
- Start time will be at 9:00AM each day.
- Finish time will be approximately 4.00 p.m. each day.
- There will be a short morning and afternoon break with a one hour lunch break.

Stalls:

- All horses must be stabled if staying on the facility overnight.
- Participants are responsible for cleaning their stall the entire duration of the clinic and on the departing day. Shavings are available at \$6/bag. Please empty all muck buckets in the spreader that will be parked just outside the barn. Thank You.
- Please no portable pens or tying horses to trailer overnight.

Food/Drinks:

- We will have some snacks and drinks available for the clinic breaks. Please bring your own lunch and a chair.
- There are also several restaurants in downtown Greenville (1.5 miles away). A map and directions to these locations can be picked up when you check in.
- Depending on the weather, I suggest we do a potluck Saturday night after the clinic, we can have a camp fire and we can grill out that night. We can order pizza or go out for dinner at a great Mexican restaurant (Jesse's Favorite). Please let me know what you prefer and what your suggestions are. I will have coffee available each morning, as well as water and other cold drinks.

Lodging/Camping:

- The clinic will start at 9am. You can arrive the evening before. I will be at the premises to welcome you – please let me know your ETA.
- Electric & Non electric camping: \$15/night, pay upon arrival to coordinator.
- Note that Electric is available as an extension cord plug into the barn 15 amp service.

Clothing:

- Please wear comfortable clothing/proper riding apparel i.e. boots and helmet. We will be in an outdoor arena. Hat, sunglasses, sunscreen, bug spray, rain gear and a beverage container are suggested.

Equipment and Other Items to Bring:

- Please label all of your tack and equipment with your name. Please keep all tack and other items at your trailer or camp site. All of the following items would be helpful to bring to the clinic:
 - Carrot Stick and String (extra Savvy string recommend to be in your pocket throughout clinic)
 - Halter and 12' lead and 22' Line (45'line optional)
 - Bareback pad (optional)
 - Bridle (Freestyle/Trail, Cradle) or Natural Hackamore
 - Saddle and Cinches and pad and shims if you have them (limited Parelli saddles available to try out)
 - Level 3-4: 45' Line, 22' Feather Lines
 - Brushes, fly spray
 - If you camp: flashlight for getting around at night
 - Horsenality Chart, filled out (Available at www.parelli.com or Jesse Peters Downloads Page www.jesserpeters.com)
 - Please bring your own hay, grain, feed pans and water buckets. (Jesse has a Clover Grass mix hay available at \$3 per bale)
 - It is also a good idea to have extra snaps and a stall card with your name and a phone number where you can be reached in case of emergencies.

Clinic Pre-requisites:

- Level 1: A thorough understanding of the basic concepts and skills as presented in the home study pack is expected. The more you know and practice from the video sets at home....the more you get out of the clinics!
- Level 2 and Advancing Level 2: You are not required to have attended a Level 1 clinic but a thorough understanding of the basic concepts and skills as presented in the home study pack is expected.
- Level 3 and Advancing Level 3: You are required to have attended a Level 2 clinic and have self-assessed through the Parelli level 2 Home study courses. At a minimum, confidence in the Walk and Trot are expected to help in increasing your development into canter for most.
- Level 4: You are required to have attended a Level 3 clinic and have self-assessed through the Parelli level 3 Home study courses. At a minimum, confidence in the Walk, Trot and Canter are expected.
- Study/Review of the Parelli Levels Packs and Parelli Patterns is recommended before attending the clinic and will accelerate your learning experience!

Participant Fees and Cancellation Policy

- Your specific fee for the clinic and all related facility expenses has been outlined in your e-mails and sent to your Clinic Coordinator in advance.
- Half of the clinic fee will be charged if a participant must back out of the clinic prior to two weeks before the start date of the clinic. The total clinic fee will be charged if it is within two weeks before the clinic. Neither of the fees will apply if a replacement is found by either the participant or clinic coordinator. If there is a medical reason or family emergency the fees can be held in deposit and used for a future clinic spot/private lessons etc. if a replacement is not found.

Auditor Fees/Information

- We love auditors! Auditors will participate in some of the simulations and exercises during the clinic/workshop. Each participant can bring 1 free auditor.
- Auditor fee is \$35/day
- Feel free to bring your pen and paper for notes. There will be no filming allowed, but take as many pictures as you like.

Stallions/Dogs

- Stallions are not permitted in the clinic.
- There are dogs on the premises; however your dog is not welcome.
